## **MA in Missional Leadership**

A three-year part-time programme that equips Christian leaders for missional leadership, and entrepreneurial or pioneering ministry and practice.

It can be completed fully online, or mainly online, with some face-to-face classes in collaboration with Missional Links Wales.





## **PROGRAMME STRUCTURE**

The first two years comprise the following five modules plus a sixth selected from options:

- MISSIONAL LEADERSHIP: FORMATION AND SKILLS
- MISSIONAL LEADERSHIP: COMMUNICATION, TRANSITION AND TEAMS
- PERSPECTIVES IN CONTEMPORARY MISSION
- RESEARCH METHODOLOGIES AND CONTEXTUAL THEOLOGY
- MISSIONAL LEADERSHIP: CONTEMPORARY CULTURE

The dissertation module is completed in the third year, on a subject of the student's choice related to Missional Leadership.

The programme is validated by Newman University and delivered by ForMission College, in collaboration with Missional Links Wales.
