The first two years comprise the following five modules plus a sixth selected from options.

- Missional Leadership: Formation and Skills
- Faith-Based Social Entrepreneurship in Contemporary Contexts
- Perspectives in Contemporary Mission
- Research Methodologies and Contextual Theology
- Faith-Based Social Entrepreneurship: Models, Approaches and Roles

The dissertation module is completed in the third year, on a subject of the student's choice related to Missional Leadership and Social Entrepreneurship.
